

AGVA Fall Update Report – October 2022



AGVA Growth Continues: AGVA began its twelfth year of offering online courses on August 24. This also marks the second year of enrolling full-time students with three enrolled in 9th grade and three in 10th grade, which is up from a single 9th grade student last year. AGVA is on track to add 11th and 12th grades over the next 2 school years. God willing, the first high school graduates will receive their AGVA diplomas in May 2025.



Partnership with Traditional Schools Continues: AGVA (formerly ALHSO) is in its 12th year of collaborating with WELS/ELS schools to expand the curricular offerings available to their students. Twenty-five WELS/ELS high schools and 27 WELS/ELS elementary schools have students enrolled in about 40 AGVA courses each semester in 2022-23. This has resulted in a record enrollment of over 350 student seats filled per semester. (See page 2 for detailed statistics by course and school.) The number of individual students enrolled in courses through AGVA is about 340, most of which are taking only one or two courses. Elementary students in grades 7-8 are generally enrolled in high school Algebra, Geometry, or Spanish courses.

More Groups Served: The number of public and home school students enrolling in AGVA courses (primarily religion, math and languages) increased dramatically over the past two years, from three students in 2020-21 to 20 this year. The increase is attributed to a greater awareness of the opportunities available through AGVA.

Several WELS/ELS congregations are exploring the possibility of adding grades 9-12 in the coming years by utilizing the services available through AGVA to provide some of the courses in an online format. AGVA is willing to meet with interested families/boards via video conferencing to demonstrate what AGVA has to offer. Administrative Changes: AGVA is pleased that Mr. David Rust has begun his work as AGVA Superintendent/Principal. Dr. Jim Grunwald will continue serving AGVA as Executive Director. Jim will concentrate on course design and construction, instructor/student technical support, registrar functions, and finances.

Planning for 2023-24: Planning is underway for the 2023-24 school year. Courses and instructors need to be determined by late November.
