

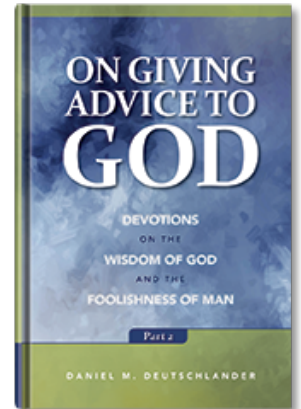

Product Author: Zach Unke

Interesting Facts about Author: Zach is a young, up-and-coming WELS piano arranger; his arrangements have gained quick popularity in our circles, and he has also been “snagged” by Augsburg Fortress; he went to MLC (not sure if he graduated) and currently lives in Las Vegas with his family where he is active in his WELS church and is focusing on his piano arranging and recording. We will be publishing more of this arranger in the future.

Product Editor: Jeremy S. Bakken

Summary of Product: 13 tunes representing a variety of genres/ styles on general hymn tunes, his settings are fairly accessible but offer some challenging moments; he’s fond of key changes; he uses the full range of dynamics and range, sometimes within a single arrangement; occasionally he pairs an unexpected genre/style with a tune (i.e. something normally contemplative he may choose to treat in with a gospel style/ feel)

Key Benefits/Features of Product: substantial settings (hymn tune is treated several times throughout an arrangement), useful throughout the church year, “something for everyone” given breadth of difficulty and style, name recognition thanks to growing reputation via Augsburg and via his personal social media presence

Different Uses for Product, including Anticipated Market: WELS churches relying somewhat heavily on piano accompaniment for worship and/or more “contemporary” treatments of hymnody, high school piano students looking for hymn-based music for lesson or personal use, other Christian worship accompanists and performers

Summary of Product: Special project / collaboration with WELS Commission on Worship and NPH for a commission honoring the service of Phil Becker (long-time organist and long-time member of WELS Commission on Worship). The preludes are based on hymns from Christian Worship: Supplement and include one tune that will first appear in a WELS publication when our new hymnal is released in 2021.

Key Benefits/Features of Product: easy to medium organ settings featuring rich harmony, pedal tones and ostinatos; could easily serve as hymn introductions (i.e. relatively short), all based on newer WELS hymnody, includes suggested registrations and tempos, website includes some live samples

Different Uses for Product, including Anticipated Market: WELS organists, other Christian organists from churches that use hymn-based music

Interesting Facts about Author: Most have contributed to other prelude collections. Louis-Bruix is new. Though we don't know much about him, his preludes are some of the longer and more developed in the collection.

Product Editor: Jeremy S. Bakken

Summary of Product: 20 organ preludes based on hymns tunes; contributions range from easy to medium difficulty and from short to medium length. Because of the number of contributors, style varies greatly. Some are 2-manual and some are 3-manual. Tunes are drawn from throughout the church year.

Key Benefits/Features of Product: "something for everybody" because of variety of style, difficulty, and span of church year; 20 tunes account for almost 40 hymn texts in Christian Worship and Christian Worship: Supplement; some include registration suggestions while others leave that to the organist

Summary of Product: new music for the familiar Drawn to the Cross text (Christian Worship 387). Each section of the choir has a "moment to shine": stanza one is unison or solo, stanza two women, stanza three men, stanza four SATB unaccompanied (though the keyboard could support the voices by playing along with the parts)

Key Benefits/Features of Product: keyboard could be either piano or organ, available in both print and digital formats, print version's blank back cover includes other "suggested titles" (all NPH)

Summary of Product: SATB setting of a piece used at the 2017 worship conference (version for unison children was used at the conference), accompanied by piano, includes optional guitar

Key Benefits/Features of Product: the Kyrie is part of the regular Sunday liturgy (Lord, Have Mercy, usually between confession and absolution or after absolution), the setting is lyrical with a flowing accompaniment (popular style these days), offered in both digital and print format, very accessible four-part writing and accompaniment (large choir and/or gifted accompanist not needed), guitar part comes with digital download and is available as a free download on the product page for print customers

Summary of Product: gathering rites have gained popularity since their inclusion in Christian Worship: Supplement. GIA has published a few Advent gathering rites that have been well received in WELS circles. This rite features continuous music throughout (similar to those in CWS). The music is based on familiar Advent hymns: the music underpinning the speaking portions of the rite comes from four different Advent hymns (all in CW). The main Advent hymn that the congregation sings throughout the rite is CWS 704 "Lo, He Comes With Clouds Descending." The rite includes confession and absolution. Most of the rite text is comprised of passages directly from Scripture.

Key Benefits/Features of Product: ties several Advent hymns into one rite, Scripture-based responses, includes confession and absolution, congregational singing, main hymn from CWS, single-fee download, includes RTF of the rite text and TIFF files of CWS 704 stanzas for easy bulletin preparation

Different Uses for Product, including Anticipated Market: all WELS churches, all Lutheran churches

Current NPH Products Related to Product: the closest related product are the Gathering Rites in Christian Worship: Supplement. Manthe is a regular contributor to other NPH music and worship products (search Manthe to see them all) including children's choral, organ preludes, and the 2017 Christmas kit.
