Parental Choice Program at LPS

At its September 2016 meeting the Governing Board of Luther Prep voted to enter the three Parental Choice Programs (Milwaukee, Racine, and Wisconsin) offered by the State of Wisconsin for the 2017-2018 school year. In these programs the State of Wisconsin offers a voucher which covers the cost of a child's tuition at a private or religious school to parents who fall below a certain income level.

The Governing Board opened up 10 seats for the Racine Program. No students applied. The Governing Board opened up 15 seats for the Milwaukee Program. We are pleased to report that all 14 applicants at the time of this writing are WELS students. The Governing Board opened up 25 seats for the Wisconsin Program. We are pleased to report that all 16 applicants at the time of this writing are WELS students.

Project Timothy 2017

This year's edition of Project Timothy marks the 25th year that Luther Prep has sent junior and senior students to various congregations and mission fields across the country and the world. It was noted by President Crass, "Hundreds of students have participated in this ministry experience. We've reached a point in its history where we have many of our former Project Timothy participants serving the congregations to which we are sending students." Over 55 students and chaperones will be making trips to various congregations. These trips have been the deciding factor for numerous students to continue their studies at Martin Luther College for full time ministry.
