Ministry of Christian Giving

WELS Ministry of Christian Giving serves on behalf of the Conference of Presidents to encourage every WELS member to excel in the grace of giving through Christ. It is our privilege to help God's people offer gifts to Jesus for his work in their congregations, synod, and WELS-affiliated ministries. The MCG manages funding from two main areas: Congregational Mission Offerings (CMO) and direct gifts to WELS.

Over the past biennium, the MCG...

- Contracted a consulting firm, Bentz Whaley Flessner (BWF), to review the MCG.
- Oversaw CMO and encouraged 98% of WELS churches to participate. In 2021, congregations set new records with their offerings for the honor and glory of Jesus.
- Encouraged funding initiates across the synod through programs such as "Equipping Christian Witnesses" and local giving.

Over the next biennium, the MCG...

- Will work with the Board for Home Missions to fund 100 new missions in 10 years.
- Will work to connect more pastors, congregations and individuals to the resources that are produced by the MCG.
