

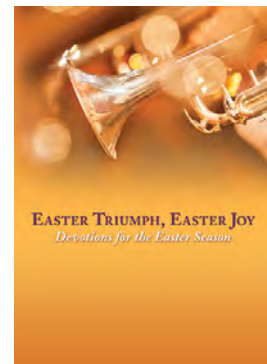

What Is It?
