# Fairbanks, Light of the World—Jason Strong, CP

- Worship attendance has been up significantly over the past month (about a 10 person/week increase from the beginning of the year). It's been a combination of a few members returning, as well as a few repeat prospects (4 of whom began BIC a few weeks ago). We're continuing to work on improving our prospect management.
- Playground equipment is purchased and looking at delivery in July. Now we're
  assessing a couple of options for where to put up the equipment, as well as
  making final plans for ground prep and any further funding.
- Our live-streaming plan is working through a couple of internet issues, but
  equipment is being purchased and we're looking at setting up as soon as we can
  work through those problems.
- Mornings with Mommy continues to do well, and we are in discussions of how to add a second session (potentially another day in the same week). That will only be able to happen if we can get more members involved, so please keep those efforts in your prayers!
- We are planning a larger outreach event (a family day) for this summer. We're hopeful that we'd be able to get a WELS Mission Journey team to come up for that (have reached out to Shannon Bohme but haven't heard back yet).
- Our leaders have been talking recently about how to better keep our vision in front of our members. The goal right now is to develop visual materials for our core values to post around church. We've also come up with an acronym to better remember our core values - Cross-SIGHTED.

- Six youth have started Catechism class

- Inreach/Outreach team is planning "First Sunday" activities for both fellowship and outreach
- Original parsonage remodel is complete. A few additional touch-ups are still being finished.

- Been seeing a few more faces in worship as of late! Some are Peace members that we haven't seen in a while. Some are new visitors who came in response to an invite from a friend... almost like friendship evangelism works!
- Currently have 2 BIC classes going. One is about to finish; another to begin shortly after Easter.

- Been meeting with some architects about the possibility of expansion at Peace. It
  would specifically revolve around our need for more PreK space. Our hope is that
  we can add an additional classroom and connect more kids/families to Christ.

- Art Camp from July 13-15 will feature a team from MLC. Peace's Parking Lot
   Party to follow on that Sunday. Hoping for some taco trucks and outdoor games.

- Faith participated in Anchorage's Fur Rondy parade and handed out 700 water bottles with information about our ministry inside to the crowds of people lining the streets.
- Our midweek Lenten services have been well received. Some weeks, our midweek attendance has almost matched Sunday English services! We've been blessed by the virtual pulpit swap.
- During the season of Lent, we are offering midweek worship services into the homes of members, friends and prospects of Iglesia Luterana de Fe en Cristo.
